

AYSO Region 45 – Game Field Procedures

Last Updated: September 2nd, 2009.

General Comments:

Web Youth Soccer lists both the Home and the Away team as having NETS for the first and last games of the day on a given field.

For field setup, both teams should have parents assisting in NETS duty. Ultimately, it is the responsibility of the HOME team to get the field ready for play, but given that we can't change Web Youth Soccer to only list the Home team, please have parents from the AWAY team help out. For field take down after the last game, parents from both teams should aid in the take down of the nets and goals.

The 6.5' x 18.5' U8 goals as well as the full sized goals for Huff Large and Montclair are a different style of goal. They are "In Ground" goals meaning that instead of the structure supporting the goal, the goals have stakes on the 4 corners (one for each goal post and one for each of the two supports in the back) which you drive into the ground. This will require assembly and threading of the nets through the crossbar (**please thread or weave the top of the net through the crossbar** – we have not provided enough Velcro to adequately attach the top of the net – just the sides and support bars).

Field Specific Procedures:

Blach Intermediate School

1120 Covington Ave, Los Altos, CA 94024

Parking: Two parking lots located on Covington Road

Typical Game Use: U14, occasional U16 and U19

Field: Located inside the track just off of Covington east of the school

Game Setup and Storage: Full-sized portable goals are locked to the fence adjacent to the field. Nets and such are stored in the storage lock box located by the side fence. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Bubb Elementary School

525 Hans Ave, Mountain View, CA 94040

Parking: Street parking behind the school on Barbara Ave and adjacent streets. There is also a parking lot in front of the school on Hans Ave but is pretty distant from the field.

Typical Game Use: U6 and U10

Field: Located in back of the school on Barbara Ave

Game Setup and Storage: For U10, permanent goals installed by the city of Mountain View. Nets and such are stored in the storage lock box located by fence near the brown shed. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder. For the U6 program, the pop-up goals are stored in the brown shed along with all of the other equipment. The shed will be unlocked and locked by designated shed volunteers before and after the U6 session.

AYSO Region 45 – Game Field Procedures

Castro School Park

505 Escuela Ave, Mountain View, CA 94040

Parking: Street parking along Latham Ave or the front parking lot on Escuela Ave.

Typical Game Use: Intermittent backup U7 and U8 field.

Field: Located at the back of the school along Latham Ave.

Game Setup and Storage: Portable goals will either be placed in the storage lock box located along the back fence or will be brought to the field. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Cooper Park

502 Chesley Ave, Mountain View, CA 94040

Parking: Street parking on Chesley Ave. There is a small parking lot on Eunice Ave but is pretty distant from the field.

Typical Game Use: U12 and U14

Field: Located along Chesley Ave.

Game Setup and Storage: Permanent goals installed by the city of Mountain View. Nets and such are in the storage lock box to the right of the field near Chesley Ave. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Crittenden Middle School

1701 Rock Ave, Mountain View, CA 94043

Parking: Use the parking lot on Middlefield Road on the west side of the fields (the lot closest to the soccer field and away from Callahan Park which is the fenced in baseball diamond). This is located near Middlefield Road and Farley St.

Typical Game Use: U12

Field: Located along Middlefield Road west of Callahan Park

Game Setup and Storage: Full-sized portable goals are locked to the fence adjacent to the field. There is a key for the goals locked inside the storage box. The key attached to a ring with cone. Please return the key to the storage box and lock the box! Nets and such are stored in the storage lock box located by the baseball diamond. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Graham Middle School

1175 Castro Street, Mountain View, CA 94040

Parking: Front parking lots on Castro St.

Typical Game Use: Occasional U14, U16 and U19

Field: Located to the right of the school by the Mountain View Sports Pavilion

Game Setup and Storage: Permanent goals with nets located on the All Weather Turf field. The corner flags are locked in the equipment storage D next to the track. Key needs to be picked up from the fields director prior to your arrival at the field.

(fields@ayso45.org) The last team of the day needs to return the key to the fields director. NOTE: Only WATER is allowed on the All Weather Turf field or the running track. All other food and snacks must be consumed on the blacktop away from the field or track.

Huff Elementary School

253 Martens Ave, Mountain View, CA 94040

Parking: Front parking lot on Martens Ave. **DO NOT PARK on Carol Ave** to make use of the back entrance to the fields.

Typical Game Use: Huff Large: U10 and U12, Huff Small: U7 or U8

Fields: Located at the back of the school. The field designated Huff Small is located to the left by the playgrounds. The field designated Huff Large is located to the back by the baseball diamond.

Game Setup and Storage: Two sets of portable goals are stored in the green Pony baseball shed by the baseball diamond. The 8' x 24' goals are to be used on Huff Large and the 6.5' x 18.5' goals are to be used for U8 on Huff Small. The bags for the goals are labeled correctly for Huff Small and Huff Large. At the end of the day, make sure the correct goals, nets, and flags are returned to the correct bag and locked in the shed. The key to the lock for this shed is attached to a long link chain and is stored in the storage lock box located near the shed by the baseball diamond. PLEASE MAKE SURE that the key ends up in the storage lock box and is not locked inside the shed. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Landels Elementary School

115 West Dana Street, Mountain View, CA 94041

Parking: Front parking lot on Dana St. Minimal neighborhood parking on Mercy St, but preferred to use main parking lot

Typical Game Use: U10

Field: Located at the back of the school

Game Setup and Storage: Permanent goals installed by the city of Mountain View. Nets and such are stored in the storage lock box along the back fence near the alley way to Mercy Street. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Loyola Elementary School

770 Berry Ave, Los Altos, CA 94024

Parking: Front parking lot on Berry Ave

Typical Game Use: U7

Fields: Located at the back of the school. The fields are designated Loyola A and Loyola B and should be painted clearly on the field. If not, please notify the field director. (fields@ayso45.org)

Game Setup and Storage: Two sets of portable 5' x 10' goals are stored in the storage lock box located on the back fence. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Montclair Elementary School and Park

1160 St. Joseph Ave, Los Altos, CA 94024

Parking: Front and side parking lot located on St. Joseph Ave to the right of the school.

Street parking on Stonehaven by the tennis courts and park.

Fields: Located at the back of the school.

Typical Game Use: U10 and U12. A field west of the main field may be used occasionally for U7 games.

Game Setup and Storage: One set of portable 8' x 24' goals are stored in the off white shed located by the tennis courts behind the far baseball diamond. The combination to the shed can be found in the coaches' binder.

Oak Avenue Elementary School

1501 Oak Ave, Los Altos, CA 94024

Parking: Front parking lot on Oak Ave. **DO NOT PARK on Ridgemont Drive or Shady Spring Lane** to make use of the back entrance to the fields.

Typical Game Use: U7

Field: Located at the back of the school. The field designated Oak A is the one next to the storage box. The field designated Oak B is to the right behind the garden.

Game Setup and Storage: Two sets of portable 5' x 10' goals are stored in the storage lock box located to the left by the permanent shed structure. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Slater School Park

160 North Whisman Road, Mountain View, CA 94043

Parking: Parking lot between old school and the field off Whisman Ave. There is also a parking lot in front of the school on Gladys but is pretty distant from the field.

Typical Game Use: U10

Field: Located on Whisman

Game Setup and Storage: Permanent goals installed by the city of Mountain View. Nets and such are stored in the storage lock box located by the baseball diamond. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Springer Elementary School

1120 Rose Ave, Mountain View, CA 94040

Parking: Front parking lot on Rose Ave

Typical Game Use: U8, occasional U10

Fields: Located at the back of the school. The field designated Springer B is to the right by the playground. The field designated Springer A is to the left by the basketball courts

Game Setup and Storage: Two sets of portable 6.5' x 18.5' goals are stored in the green Pony baseball shed by the baseball diamond. The key to the lock for this shed is attached to a long link chain and is stored in the storage lock box located on the back fence.

PLEASE MAKE SURE that the key ends up in the storage lock box and is not locked inside the shed. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Stevenson Park

Montecito Ave, Mountain View, CA 94043

Stevenson Park is located behind Theuerkauf Elementary School at 1625 San Luis Ave, Mountain View, CA 94043

Parking: Small parking lot on Montecito Ave. along with street parking along Montecito Ave.

Typical Game Use: U16 and U19

Field: Located by Montecito Ave

Game Setup and Storage: Permanent goals installed by the city of Mountain View. Nets and such are stored in the storage lock box located by the baseball diamond closest to Montecito Ave. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.

Whisman School Park

400 Easy Street, Mountain View, CA 94043

Parking: Front parking lot on Easy St. which tends to fill up. Other parking is on Easy St as well as Alamo Court and Taylor Court off of Walker Drive.

Typical Game Use: U12

Field: Located behind the parking lot

Game Setup and Storage: Permanent goals installed by the city of Mountain View. Nets and such are stored in the storage lock box located by the baseball diamond. The combination to the storage lock box can be found in the coaches' binder.
